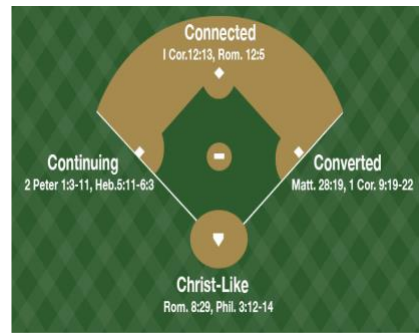

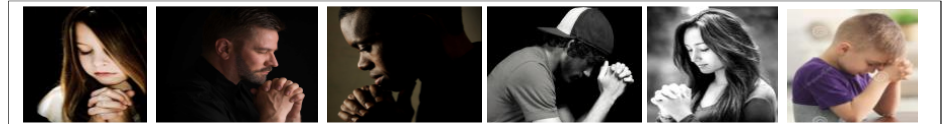
Following services in the gym!
