EQUIP TEACHING & MINISTRY WORKSHOP

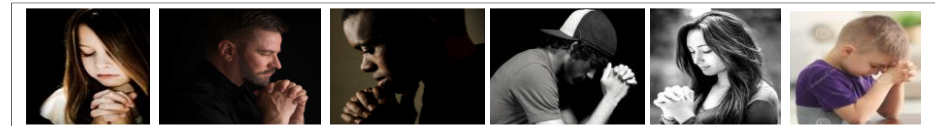
Brown St. Church of Christ Waxachie, TX Teaching & Ministry Workshop September 10th -11th
