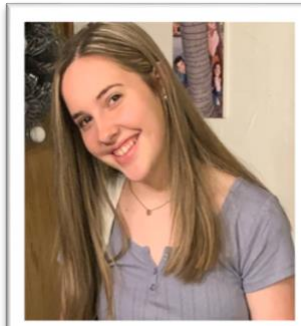

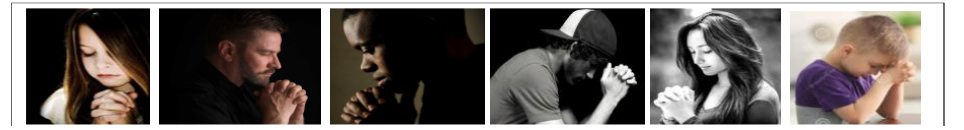
CANDY NEEDED
