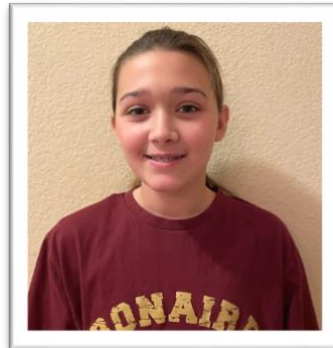

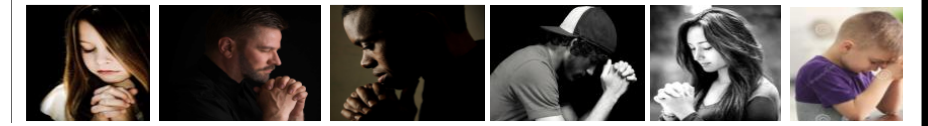


Ladies' Bible Class
